Judge Oshrine found Mr. Redmond guilty and sentenced him to 3 years in the custody of the Division of Corrections. The execution of sentence was suspended, and Mr. Redmond was granted 3 years supervised probation with the condition that he pay \$105.00 court costs to the Sheriff by 12/28/88. A special condition to perform 100 hours of community service was also imposed. On 10/31/88, Mr. Redmond reported to the Guilford Avenue Office for the initial interview. At that time, the terms and conditions of probation were read and explained to him, and he was given the opportunity to ask questions. This writer received this case on 11/9/88 and has maintained supervision in the Non-Active Category.

HISTORY OF SUPERVISION:

While under supervision, Mr. Redmond resided at 6717 Harewood Park Drive with his sister, Ms. Kathleen Wilson. Additionally, he has been unemployed and was supported by a Social Security check in the amount of \$368.00 per month. 



Mr. Redmond was a former Heroin Addict who has been on Methodone Maintenance Programs and Detoxification Programs throughout the probationary period. Prior to his incarceration, he was attending the Substance Abuse Program at the Francis Scott Key Medical Center. It was also discovered that Mr. Redmond had a serious alcohol problem. Mr. Redmond has also performed 100 hours of community service in a satisfactory manner. The court costs of \$105.00 have been paid in full. During this period, Mr. Redmond has reported as instructed and has kept this writer abreast of his status. Overall his adjustment to supervision has been unsatisfactory.

REASON FOR REPORT:

The primary purpose of this report is to initiate violation proceedings against Mr. Redmond for failing to Obey all Laws.

The case was remanded to the Circuit Court for Baltimore City under Indictment Number 89001045. On 3/30/90, Mr. Redmond appeared before Judge Davis and was convicted of Theft. Judge Davis sentenced him to 6 months and 6 months consecutive dating from 3/20/90. He is currently incarcerated at Maryland Reception Diagnostic Classification Center under DOC # 205-157. All other pending Theft charges previously mentioned are scheduled for 4/30/90 in the Circuit Court for Baltimore City.

SPECIFICATION OF CONDITIONS VIOLATED:

In light of the aforementioned facts, this writer alleges that Mr. Redmond has violated the following condition of his probation:

CONDITION #4 OBEY ALL LAWS.

By being convicted of Theft in the CCBC on 3/30/90 under Indictment Number 89001045. Offense occurred 11/17/89.

EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATION:

Mr. Redmond is a 50 year old White male with a limited education and minimal job skills who has been under supervision for 18 months. During this period, he has reported as instructed, paid the court costs in full and has completed 100 hours of his community service. In contrast, Mr. Redmond has been arrested on 6 occasions for Theft, one of which has resulted in a conviction. His basic problems are the multiple addictions of alcohol and drugs. Although the drug addiction is under control, he has a serious alcohol problem. He has received counseling, however, he needs to be placed in a long term inpatient alcohol program. Since he has been convicted and is serving a one year sentenced for Theft, this writer respectfully requests that a Warrant be issued charging him with Violation of Probation.

Should the charges be sustained, this writer would respectfully recommend that Mr. Redmond's probation be revoked and the original sentence be imposed.

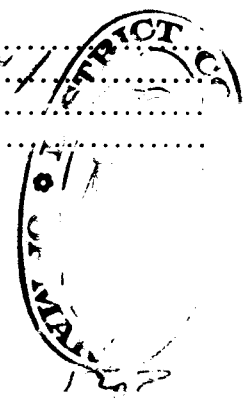
