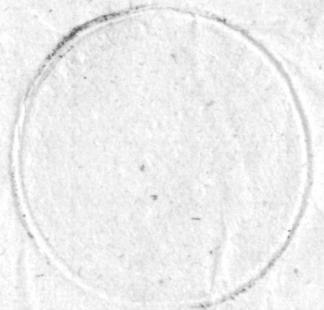

time Six Hundred dollars.

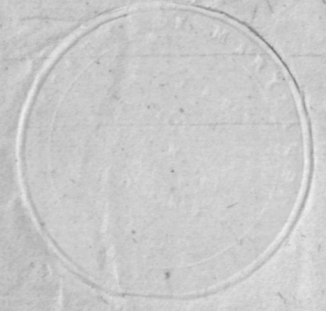
