Return of the negro slaves the property of Aquila Deall of the County of Prince Georges and state of Maryland, which were taken or conveyed away by the British in the month of August 1814 and also their value at said period.

On this 31th day of December Eighteen Hundred and twenty two personally appears Aquila Deall and makes oath on the Holy Evangelij of Almighty God that the foregoing statement is true to the best of his knowledge

On this Eleventh day of December Eighteen Hundred and twenty two appears Philemon Chum and makes oath on the Holy Evangelij of Almighty God that at the time the above mentioned negro man Tom was taken or conveyed away by the British he would have sold for five hundred dollars.

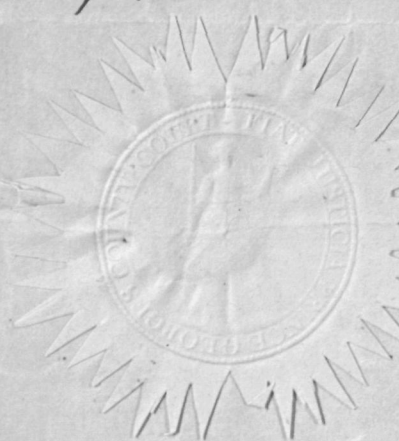

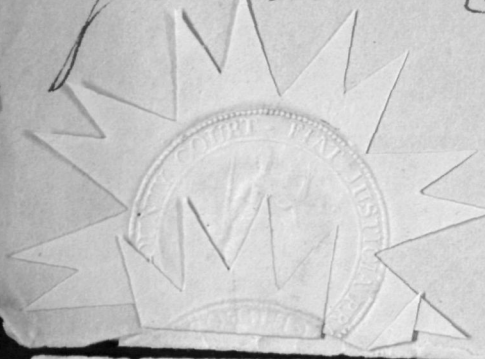
Be it remembered that on this 17th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty eight personally appeared before the subscriber a Justice of the peace in and for the State and County aforesaid John Fowler a Competent Witness and made oath on the holy Evangel of Almighty God that he was well acquainted with a negro man slave named Tom the rightfull property of Aquila Beall of Prince Georges County in the said State who was taken and carried away by the force of his Britanick Majesty in the year Eighteen hundred and fourteen and has not since been heard of in the said State and that the said negro man slave before he went away was usually called and known by the name of Tom Wheeler —
