Be it remembered that Daniel Lewis personally appeared this Twentysixth day of February in the Year Eighteen Hundred & Twentyeight before the subscriber a Justice of the Peace in and for the aforesaid County & State and made oath on the Holy Evangelge of Almighty God that the negro woman Kitty the property of his late Father Thomas Lewis decd, who absconded from said Thomas Lewis & went on board the British Squadron in the Year Eighteen Hundred & fourteen - had when young assumed the Sir name of Hooks, being the name of the person of whom said Thomas Lewis had purchased her Father - But she took up with a negro man Sir named Brown, whose name she may have assumed altho not legally married to him.

 On this thirteenth day of May 1823 before me the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County appears George W. Bycoe, and makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that in the month of September in the year 1814 he obtained permission from the Department of War to visit the British Fleet then lying in the mouth of Patuxent River, and that, about the time he arrived on board the British Ship Dragon Commanded by Commodore Parice, he saw a negro woman named Kitty the property of Thomas Lewis come on board said ship, and that to the best of his knowledge & recollection he thinks she appeared to be about thirty years of age.
