I Thomas Kingborough being duly sworn do make oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that on or about the month of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and fourteen my negro man Solomon and his wife Hannah for life ran off and went on board some of the British Vessels lying in Tarpier Towne and were by them carried away. That they were stout and healthy young men - their ages were between twenty one and twenty eight years, and according to the prices current for negroes, at that time, they would have sold for the sum of four hundred dollars each. Witness my hand and seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.
