me Notary long and well known and worthy of full faith and credit and made oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he was a partner in the late firm of Yates & Harrison of this city vendue masters, that referring to their books he finds that said firm at the request of Messrs. Rodger & Sausdale on the ninth of March one thousand eight hundred and fifteen sold a quantity of Maryland Tobacco, then laying at different Tobacco inspection houses on the river Patuxent and delivered at said inspection houses at from five dollars to five dollars and ninety cents per 100 lbs for second quality and at from seven dollars to seven dollars and ninety cents per 100 lbs for first quality and that said sale of Tobacco was the first public sale of Tobacco made in this city after the late peace between the United States and Great Britain as this deponent verily believes.

Of which an Act having been of me requested, I have granted these presents to serve and avail as need and occasion may require.

Firm of Hodges & Lansdale and other Citizens of the United
States aforesaid and was, as is stated in the depositions
hereto appended, violently and forcibly, taken possession of by
his Britannic Majesty's Forces during the late War on or
about the month of June Eighteen Hundred and Four-
teen and carried away or destroyed by them and
that the said Three Hundred and Twenty Hogsheads
of Tobacco was worth at that time, for the first quality,
and Ninety Cents per hundred pounds of Tobacco and
from Five Dollars to Six Dollars and Ninety Cents for
the second quality, as is specially sworn to in the
aforesaid affidavit of Hall Harrison, marked N^o. 4.

This deponent further saith that he verily believes
that such of the said Tobacco as was not destroyed
or the proceeds thereof which must have netted

far beyond as the sums estimated in No. 4 was in the hands of the British on the 24th of December 1814. but of this fact he has been unable to get any specific proof not having access to the returns of his ^{Britannic} Majesty's officers engaged in the War, or other evidences in their possessions.

Lawrence, and makes oath on the holy evangelists of Almighty God, that he is now, and has been for the last four years Inspector of Tobacco at Lower Marlbro Warehouse in said County, and has had charge of the Books during that time which contains an account of all the Tobacco received at, and delivered from said Warehouse, since the year eighteen hundred and five, and that it appears from entries made in said Books in the hand writing of his predecessor Gavin A. Smith that the nineteen hogsheads Tobacco mentioned in the within manifest were "burnt by the British forces June 17th 1814". The Deponent further states that the said Gavin A. Smith died before Deponent came into office.

On this second 2nd day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty four, before me, a Justice of the Peace for Calvert County, appears David Kent, and makes oath in due form of law, that in the month of June, eighteen hundred and fourteen the British forces landed at Lower Marlbro in Calvert County, and took possession of the Tobacco Warehouse at that place, and removed from thence a quantity of Tobacco stored therein, and afterwards burnt the said Warehouse with all the Tobacco which remained therein, and he has no doubt from the entries made in the Warehouse Books in the hand writing of Gavin A. Smith, who was the Inspector at that time, that the whole of the nineteen hogsheads Tobacco mentioned in the within manifest was taken away or destroyed by the said British forces. The Deponent further states that the said Gavin A. Smith departed this life about four years ago.
