The state of Maryland Queen Anns County to wit, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July  
in the year eighteen hundred and twenty one personally appeared before me one  
of the Justices of the peace for Queen Anns County James Benton a  
citizen of Queen Anns County who made oath on the holy evangelist of almighty  
god that on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1813, the British Troops under  
the command of Sir Sidney Beckwith accompanied by the naval command  
of Admiral Warren took possession of Kent Island and continued to  
occupy the same untill about the twenty second day of the same month, that  
during the same time the British took from him, One Negro Slave  
named Perry of the age of 25 years of the value of five hundred Dollars  
one Negro Slave named Emory of the age of 23 years of the value of five  
hundred Dollars one young mare of the value of seventy Dollars  
nineteen sheep & seven Lambs of the value fifty nine Dollars & fifty cents  
nine Geese of the value of four Dollars and fifty cents, seven Turkeys  
of the value of five Dollars and twenty five cents one hog of the value  
of one Dollar, fifteen Ducks of the value of two Dollars and seventy  
cents one Barrel corn of the value of Three Dollars and twenty five cents  
two saddles and bridles half worn of the value of twelve Dollars two  
canoes of the value of Ten Dollars, At the same time personally appeared  
John Rodney and made oath in like manner that he knew Perry & Emory  
mentioned in the deposition of James Benton that he believes them to have  
been at the time mentioned in the said deposition of the ages of 25 & 23  
years and that he verily believes them to have been at the time they  
were taken of the value of five hundred Dollars each, sworn to  
before me —
