Maryland. Prince Georges County to Wit:

On this thirtieth day of September in the year eighteen hundred and twenty three, before me the subscriber a Justice of the Peace of the said State in and for the County aforesaid. Appears Francis Dyer of Alexandria County in the District of Columbia, who being sworn on the holy Evangelij of Almighty God, deposes and says; that some time in the month of May, eighteen hundred and fifteen, he this deponent was at the Port of St. George's in the Island of Bermuda, and that he there saw and conversed with, the following Negroes to Wit: Baptist the property of Martha Statten, now deceased, Charles, the property of the heirs of Geo Statten, dec<sup>d</sup>, and James, the property of Basil Statten, - this deponent has known the above named Negroes from their infancy, and verily believing they ~~were taken from~~ their places of nativity and voluntarily went on board of some of the Vessels of the British Squadron, which lay near Fort Washington, in the month of September 1814
