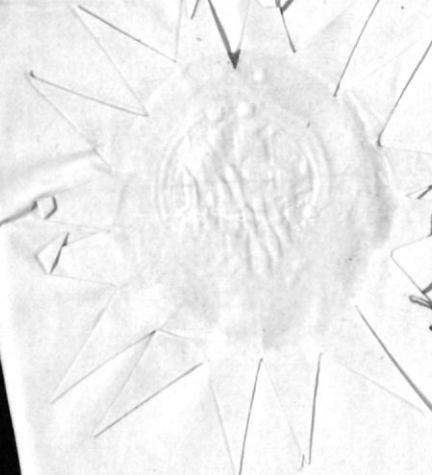


Saint Marys County Court

and twenty one filed in my office a certificate of  
his qualifications as one of the Justices of the Peace  
of Saint Marys County aforesaid, I also certify that  
the said George (Teal), <sup>was</sup> appointed by the Governor &  
Council for 1822 & 1823 as a Justice of the Peace

State of Maryland: Saint Marys County to wit.

On this 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821. Personally appeared George Wise before me the subscribed one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County, and made oath on the Holy Evangelly of Almighty God, that Negro Joseph the property of John St Jackson of the County aforesaid was taken by the British in the Month of May 1814. and that the age of the said Negro was about 24 years. to the best of his Knowledge and belief.

On this 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821, personally appears George Wise and William H. B Sewall before me the subscribed one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County and made oath on the Holy Evangelly of Almighty God, that they would well and truly without Partiatity or prejudice value the following Negro Slave the property of John St Jackson, which was taken by the British in the month of May 1814. from the Shore of Patuxent River in Saint Marys County to the best of their skill and Judgment
