To wit: I Aaron Wingate

of Somerset County and State of Maryland, in the Republic of
the United States of America, do hereby Certify
that in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Fourteen, in
the month of November, while peacefully navigating
the waters of the Chesapeake Bay & the River
Potomack being properly authorized by the Collector
of the Port of Annapolis as Skipper of a Schooner
called the Liberty of the above Port, George Parker
owner, the Schooner being unarmed was captured
in the above River by His Britannic Majesty's Brig
Saracen, I with the Crew was carried to Tangier
there being in this Crew a Negro man named Hamilton
belonging to the aforesaid George Parker, of a dark
Complexion about five feet ten inches high or there
abouts being about twenty three years of age of
sound body and mind, I do hereby further Certify that
when I was liberated from the said Brig that the
above named Negro was detained.

of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred
and Twenty four.

Somerset County } To wit: I Elisha Parker of Sussex County
and State of Delaware, but formerly of Somerset County and State of
Maryland, do hereby Certify that in the year of our Lord One
thousand, eight hundred and fifteen, in the month of January
by Virtue of a Warrant granted by Col. Thomas Blum-
berghs of the 25th Regt. of Maryland Militia, I proceeded to
Ferguson Harbour, on board of His Britannic Majesty's Brig
Sarcen, did there and there demand a Negro Man named
Camilla Captured on board of a Schooner called the Liberty
of Vienna, Aaron Wingate, Master, and that the said Negro
was not delivered, said Negro belonged to a certain
George Parker of Somerset County and State of Maryland.
Given under my hand this 20th day of
February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty
four.
