- a. Baltimore *News*. Typed version of an unsigned published article concerning the consideration of Baldwin as a member of the Baltimore's School Board. Note the phrase "Unless something unexpected turns up" that we interpret to mean that the author of the piece knew that something was about to be turned up.

b. Chávez telegram to Baldwin from Ciudad México asking how many people are in Baldwin's party. We believe that this reflects the precipitousness of Baldwin's departure from Baltimore.
