

O'CONNOR RITES TOMORROW

Senator Johnson, Tawes, Grady To Be Pallbearers

Senate Majority Leader Lyndon Johnson, Governor Tawes and Mayor Grady are included in the list of honorary pallbearers for Herbert R. O'Connor, former Governor and United States Senator, who died Friday.

Senator Johnson has notified the O'Connor family that he will attend the funeral tomorrow if it is at all possible for him to do so. The civil-rights filibuster, expected to resume again in the Senate today, might, however, prevent him from leaving Washington, he said.

The funeral will be held at 9.10 A.M. from Mr. O'Connor's home at 101 Highfield road. A requiem mass will follow at 10 A.M. in the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen. The Most Rev. Francis P.

Keough, Archbishop of Baltimore, will officiate at the mass and attending ceremonies.

Assisting the Archbishop will be Msgr. Lawrence J. Kilkenny, Msgr. Roger Wooden, the Rev. Thomas Whelan, the Rev. Claire O'Dwyer, Msgr. Vincent Hopkins and the Rev. Aloysius C. Galvin, S. J.

The Rev. Vincent Beatty, S. J., president of Loyola College, will read a eulogy.

Mrs. O'Connor, who suffered a heart attack shortly after the death of her husband, has been refused permission by her physician, Dr. J. Emmett Queen, to attend the funeral. Mrs. O'Connor is presently a patient at Mercy Hospital.

Actual pallbearers will be Dailey Burns, Edward J. Burns, Dr. Vincent Fitzpatrick, Dr. William Gentry, Jr., Richard Froehlinger and Robert J. McElroy.
