



This Plat and description represent parts of several tracts known as "the Grove" or "Grove Enlarged", "Barclay's Slip" and "Prospect" of which John B. Foard, late of Harford County, dec'd, died seized, situate near Prospect P.O. in county aforesaid. The Four Lots represented on this Plat are situate on the North side of the road leading from Prospect P.O. to Dublin. Lot No. 5 lies on the South side of said road, the courses and distances of which lot will be filed hereafter. Said Lots contain in the aggregate Three Hundred and Forty acres (340) of land more or less.

Lot No. 1. Beginning at A, the beginning of the whole tract, and running on the outlines thereof two courses, as follows; S. 69 1/4 W. 35 ps., thence S. 54 1/4 W. 21 1/10 ps., thence S. 36 3/4 E. 103 ps., thence N. 40 W. 2 ps., thence N. 35 E. 2 ps., thence S. 71 E. 28 1/10 ps., thence S. 41 E. 15 ps., thence E. 106 ps., thence S. 15 E. 36 ps. to the end of the forty-first line of the whole tract thence with lines of whole tract to the place of beginning and contains 60A. 2R. 9 ps. of land, more or less.

Lot No. 2. Beginning at B, the end of 26 1/10 ps. in the second line of the whole tract and runs as per courses and distances given on plat. Lot No. 3. Beginning at C, the end of the third line of the whole tract and running as per courses and distances given on plat. Lot No. 4. Beginning at D, the end of the thirteenth line of the whole tract, and running as per courses and distances on plat. Lot No. 5 lies off from the main tract on the South side of the road leading from Prospect P.O. to Dublin, and adjoins the lands of Wm. J. Williamson John H. Smith and others.
