 and colored as in the General Map.



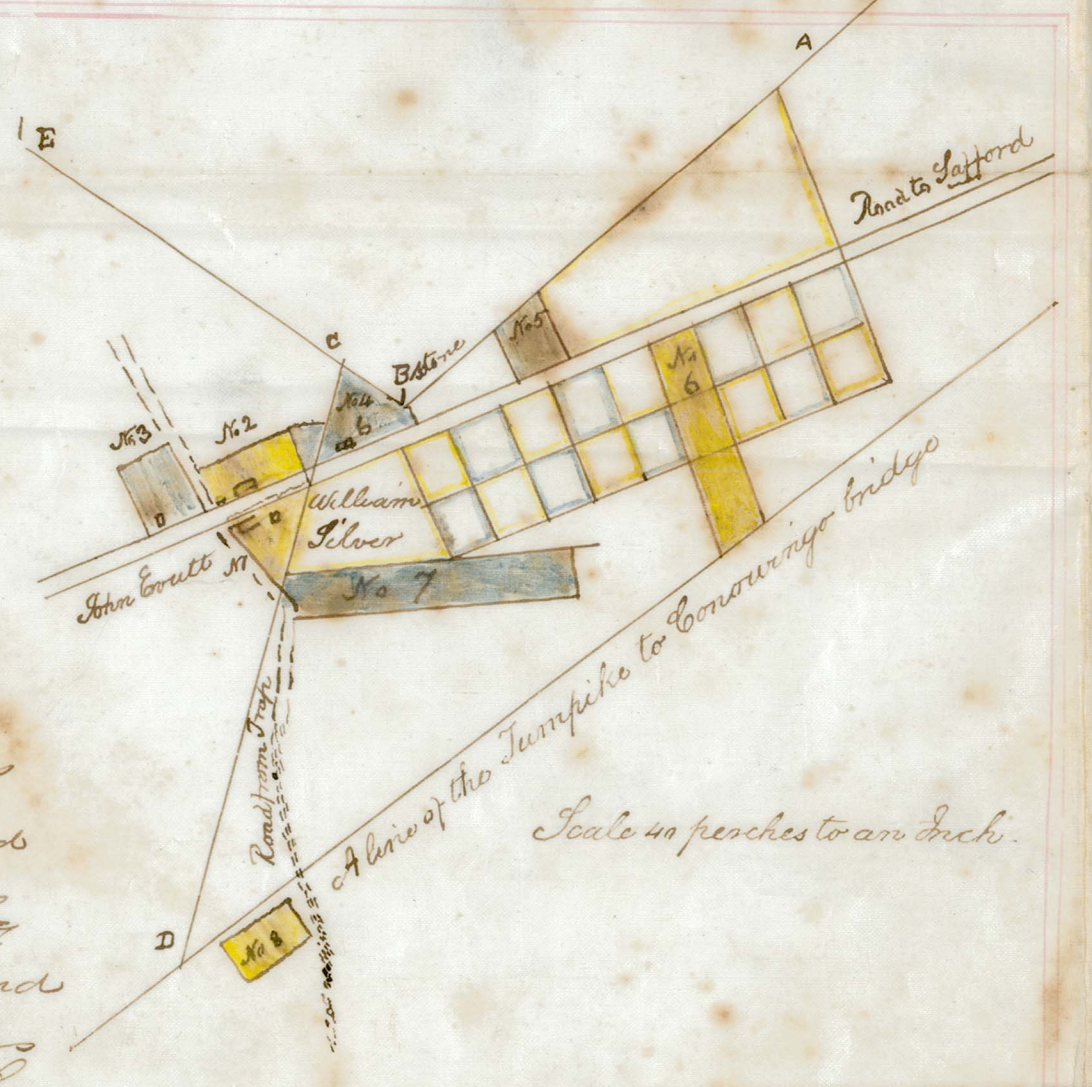
Jugquehanna river scale 4 miles to an inch.

A Plan of the village of Dublin is
 given to shew the relative situation of
 the different lots belonging to the estates;
 the lots which belong to the estate are num-
 bered and colored, the rest are only shaded.

Dublin is a part of a tract of
 lands called Drabias Town, the lines A
 B, B C and C D are parts of lines of said
 tract sold by Isaac Webster and Deco-
 rous to Walter Ashmun and the lines
 C, E D, are lines of the tract aforesaid
 sold to Michael Montgomery and by
 him to William Beavers Ashmun's land
 is on east side of those lines Beavers
 on the west side, these two titles Mc Caus-
 land hold his Dublin property
