By virtue of a special warrant granted out of his Lordships Land Office on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno Dom. 1746, to Resurvey & lay out for and in the name of Stephen Onion of Baltimore County Gent: a tract of Land lying and being in the County aforesd called Bleehill, originally on the day of \_\_\_\_\_ granted unto \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_ acres; according to its antient metes and bounds, with its Surplus, Nevertheless correcting and amending any errors in the Original Survey, and by my out-lines adding any vacant land I could find to the same contiguous, whether cultivated or otherwise &c

I Thomas White Deputy surveyor of Baltimore county, have carefully Resurveyed and laid out for & in the name of him the said Stephen Onion the aforesd tract or parcel of Land, according to its antient metes and bounds as shewed to me: Beginning at Michael Frenches spring, which runs into a small branch, called Greencoat cabin branch, and is about eighty perches, to the eastward of the said branch; and running thence South thirty deg: west, eighty perches: North thirty deg: west, eighty perches: North sixty deg: east, eighty perches: North fifty deg: east, <sup>two hundred and twenty</sup> ~~eighty~~ perches: South thirty deg: east, eighty perches; and thence by a straight line to the beginning containing and laid out for one hundred and forty eight acres, more or less, ~~fourteen~~ acres part of which lyeth within the bounds of an elder survey which I have excluded;

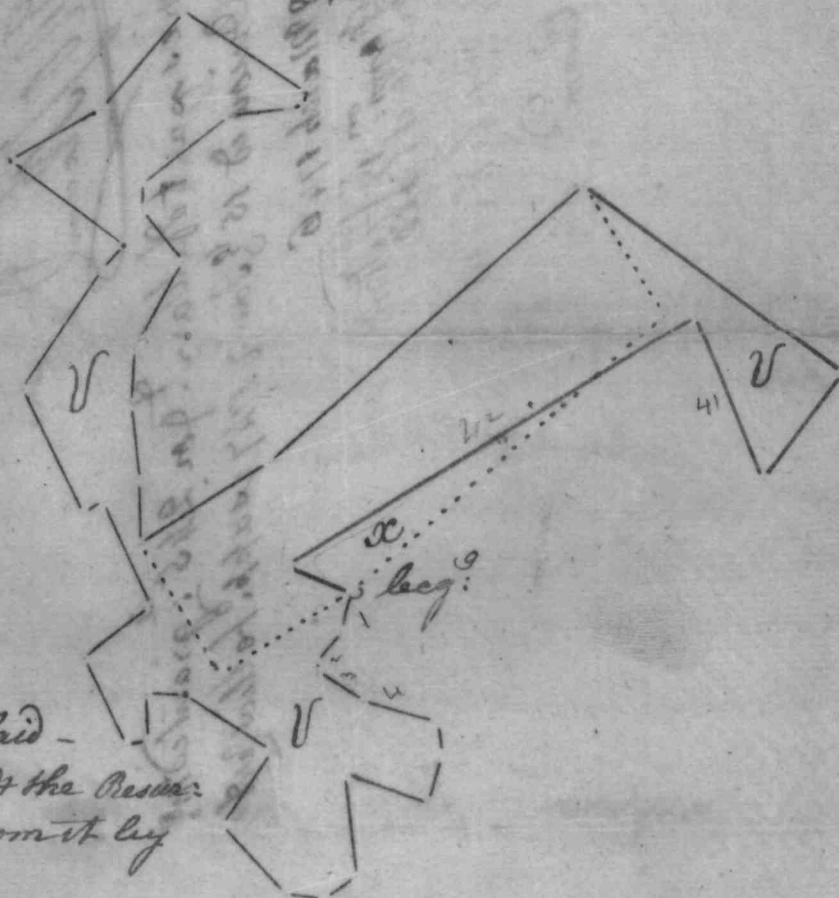
I also Certifie that I have added to the out bounds of the aforesd tract or parcel of land the quantity of one hundred and ~~eighty~~ <sup>three</sup> acres of vacant land, and have reduced the whole into one entire tract, bounded as follows Viz: Lying in Baltimore county, on the north side of Deer creek. Beginning at Michael French's Spring which runs into a small branch, called Greencoat cabin branch; and is about eighty perches, to the eastward of the said branch, and running thence South fourteen, deg: west, twenty perches; south forty three deg: west, twenty perches; South three deg: east, five perches; South, fifty two deg: east, twenty eight perches; South seventy two deg: East, forty perches; South five deg: East sixteen perches; South eighteen deg: west, twenty six perches; North sixty nine deg: west, forty six perches;
