 Reserved Lands within the Province of Maryland to lay out parcels of the
 Reserved in this County for Persons applying for the same &c —

I James Calder Deputy Surveyor of Baltimore County do hereby Certify that I have surveyed
 for Henry Guffy of Baltimore County a tract of Land part of the Proprietors Reserved
 Land in this County Beginning at a large heap of Stones placed on the West Side & near
 the top of a small hill about three hundred yards North of a Spring known by the
 Name of the Dogwood Spring emptying into Broad Creek & running there South
 fifty one degrees East sixty four perches, North forty three degrees East seventy four
 perches, North sixty nine degrees West ninety four perches, South seventy five degrees
 West fifty six perches, South thirty one degrees & three quarters West sixty two perches
 South twenty two degrees West forty perches, South fifty three degrees East thirty six
 perches, South thirty two degrees West twenty six perches, North eighty five degrees
 West fifteen perches, South fourteen degrees & a half West forty four perches, South twenty
 five degrees East sixty two perches, North sixty seven degrees East eighty perches, North
 eighty six degrees East thirty four perches & thence by a straight line to the Beginning
 containing one hundred & fifty six Acres more or less by the Name of Guffys romantick
 prospect March 2^d 1771 —

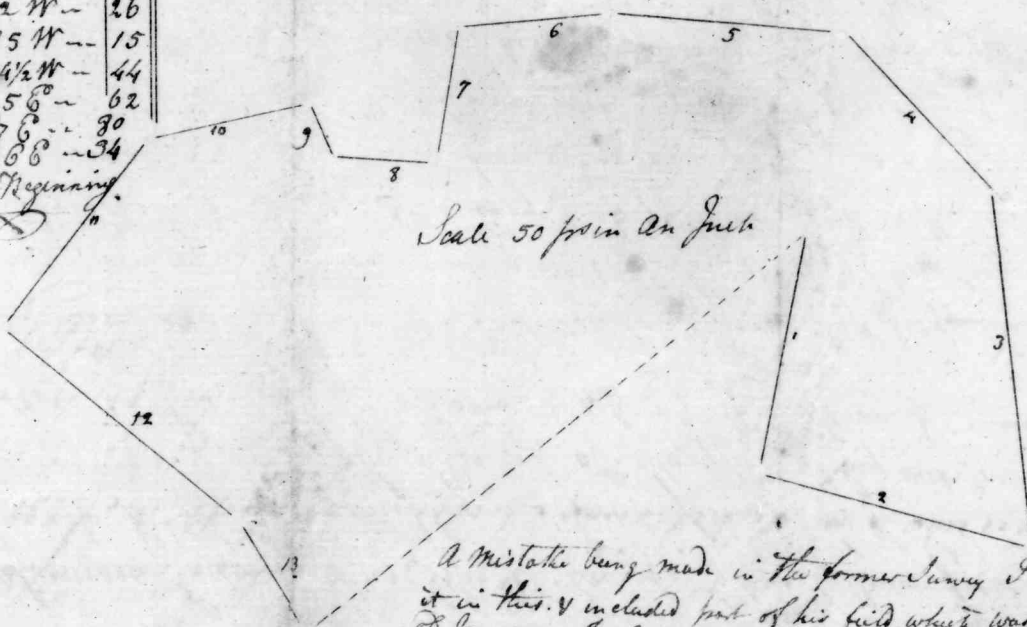
