Baltimore County Jo By Virtue of a Common Warrant granted out of his Lordships Land Office bearing date by renewment the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1768 To lay out for William Bennett of Baltimore county one hundred and Eighteen acres of Land & one other Warrant of the same Date by renewment for one hundred acres parts of which remaineth unexecuted one other Warrant bearing date by renewment the 21<sup>st</sup> of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1768 to lay out for William Bennett and Samuel Webb four Hundred acres of Land &c

I William Smith Deputy Surveyor of Baltimore County have laid out for and in the Name of them the Said William Bennett and Samuel Webb a Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County afores<sup>d</sup> Beginning at the end of Thirty eight perches on the North fifty degrees East

of a Tract of Land & lies with the East side of Hill Duland and running thence North fifty degrees East forty two perches North fifty degrees East two hundred and Twenty perches South fifty two degrees East one hundred Twenty six perches North fourteen degrees East sixty perches North twenty six degrees West eighty seven perches South thirty perches South seventy degrees West fifty seven perches North fifteen degrees West twenty perches South fifty degrees West thirty two perches North thirty seven degrees West one hundred perches South thirty seven degrees West fifty seven perches South seventy nine degrees West sixty two perches North fifty degrees West Twelve perches South fifty four degrees West thirty six perches South three degrees West fourteen perches South eighty nine degrees East eighty perches South fourteen degrees West ninety two perches North seventy five degrees West thirty four perches and thence by a straight line to the Beginning containing and laid out for One Hundred and <sup>Seventy</sup> Eight acres more or less to be hold of the manor of Baltimore by the Name of Prospect July the 1<sup>st</sup> 1768
