Harford County &c By virtue of a special Warrant of proclamation granted out of the land office on the western shore in the State of Maryland on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 to survey and lay out for Capt. Samuel Godman of Anne Arundel County about of land called Tolleys Silver Hills lying in Harford County and containing fifty six acres Surveyed for John Tolley on the 23 day of May 1794 and to Add any Contiguous Vacancy as appears &c.

I Daniel Scott surveyor of Harford County hereby certify that I survey for him the said Capt. Samuel Godman the aforesaid tract according to its ancient Mts and bounds as shewed to me, and find it contains Fifty six acres the same as Formerly Surveyed for Beginning at the beginning of a tract of Land called Prospect and Running thence And bounding on said land as <sup>the</sup> following courses Viz North Six degrees East Seventy six perches South Seventy five degrees East thirty Four perches North fourteen degrees East eighty eight perches then North ~~eighty nine degrees West~~ Sixty four degrees and a half East seven perches North eighty nine degrees West forty three perches South sixty one degrees West forty one perches South thirty six Degrees East thirteen perches South thirty degrees West fifty two perches South one hundred perches and then with a straight line to the beginning containing Fifty six acres of land more or less by the Name of Silver Hills Secured. Surveyed 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1796.
