Harford County, I hereby certify that I have surveyed and carefully laid out for John Barclay Esq. a tract or Parcel of Land in the Reserve in Harford County Beginning at Black Rock Stone in a Small Branch on the North side of Broad Creek Near the end of the South thirty degree West Sixty four Perch line of a tract of Land called Onions's Meadow Ground and Running thence North thirty degree East Sixty four perches South fifty two degree East Sixty seven perches North forty three degree East eighteen Perches North fifty two degree West One hundred and one perches North seventeen degree & an half West thirty eight Perches to a bounded White Oak standing on the North side of a branch thence North twelve degree East fifty eight Perches to a bounded White Oak standing at the end of the South forty three degree West Seventy seven perches line of a tract of Land called Pees's Enlargement <sup>North ten degree West nineteen perches</sup> thence South eighty eight degree West thirty two perches to a bounded Black Oak thence South ten degree West eighteen perches to intersect the North sixty nine degree West Ninety four perch line of a tract of Land called Guffey's Romantick prospect thence South sixty nine degree East twenty nine perches South three degree West fifty two perches South sixty four degree East thirty four perches South twenty two degree West thirty eight perches to a bounded Black Oak thence South forty nine degree East twenty eight perches South twenty seven degree & an half West thirty seven perches North thirty four degree West Sixty seven perches to a bounded White Oak on the side of a hill thence South fifty five degree West twenty four perches South fifty five degree West twenty four perches South nineteen degree East

seventy perches to a bounded Spanish Oak and thence by a straight line to the Beginning containing and laid out for Fifty five Acres and an half More or less to be held by the Name of *Fathers*

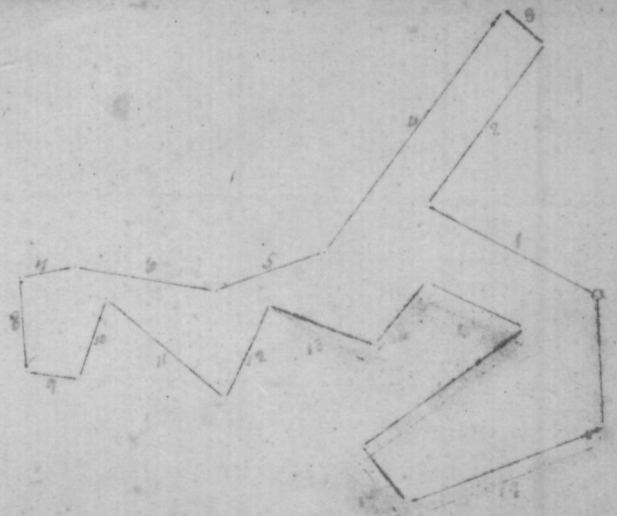
