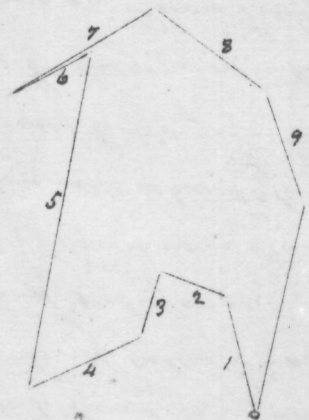
By virtue of a special warrant issued out of the Land Office on the western shore of this State on the 18th day of April 1804 to lay out for Israel Cox of Harford County five acres of vacant land lying and being in the County aforesaid adjoining a tract of land called Prospect &c. I hereby certify that I have surveyed and carefully laid out for and in the name of him the said Israel Cox a tract or parcel of land bounded as follows viz. Lying in Harford County Beginning at a bounded white oak standing at the end of the twelfth line of a tract of land called Reeves Enlargement said white oak being a boundary of the lands called Reeves Enlargement, Prospect and The Grove Enlarged and thence bounding on Reeves Enlargement the five following courses viz. South fourteen degrees East thirty two perches to a stone set in the ground then South sixty eight degrees East eighteen perches and a half to two bounded white oaks in a bottom then North sixteen degrees East eighteen perches to a stone set in the ground then North sixty five degrees East thirty two perches South ten degrees West ninety perches to the beginning of Reeves Enlargement then still bounding on Reeves Enlargement North sixty two degrees East twenty four perches and a quarter until it intersects a tract of land called Clechill Enlarged then bounding on said land Reversed South fifty nine degrees West forty four perches until it intersects the one hundred and one perch line of a tract of land called Prospect then bounding on said line North fifty three degrees West thirty six perches to the end thereof then still bounding on said land North eighteen degrees and a half West thirty two perches to a bounded white oak on the north side of a branch a boundary of said land and thence by a straight line to the beginning containing twenty seven acres and a quarter and twenty two perches more or less to be held by the name of Partnership dissolved May the 9th 1804
