or the full Value thereof in such commodities as we and our heirs or such  
Officer or officers as shall be appointed by us and our heirs from time to  
time to collect and receive the same shall accept in Discharge thereof  
at the choice of us and our heirs or such officer or officers as provided  
that if the said sum for a fine for alien shall not be paid unto us and our  
heirs or such officer or officers as before such alien and the said alien  
Entered upon Record either in the prov. C. or C. 46. where the same par-  
cell of Land lyeth within one month next after such alien then the said  
alien shall be void and of no effect given under our Great Seal of our said
