



Alterations Made by our Instructions bearing Date at London the Twelfth Day of September Seventeen hundred and Twelve and Registered in our Secretarys Office of our Said Province We do therefore hereby Grant unto him the Said Abraham Ingram all that the aforesaid Tract or parcell of Land called Sheep pen Mill Situate Lying and Being in Sommersett County on the Seaboard Side on the head of the Indian at the Baltimore River bound as followeth BEGINNING at a Marked White Oak standing on the East Side of a Branch of Said River called Shilos Branch abt. thirty Yards to the South East of the Main Road over Said Branch and near the Wading place over Said Branch and from thence w. a Line drawn North Thirty Deg. West fifteen poles thence West Eighty pole thence South One hundred and fifteen poles thence East fifty four pole and from thence with a Right Line drawn to the first Bounder containing and now Laid out for fifty Acres of Land more or Less According to the Certificate of Survey thereof taken and Returned into our Land Office bearing Date the Twentieth Day of Septe Seventeen hundred and Twenty Nine and there Remaining together with all Rights Profits Benefits and Priviledges therounto belonging (Royall Mines Excepted) To Have and to Hold the Same unto him the Said Abraham Ingram his Heirs and Assigns for Ever to be holden of us and our Heirs as of our Manor of Sommersett in Fee and Common Soilage by fealty only for all Manner of Services Yielding and Paying therefore Yearly unto us and our Heirs at our Receipt at the City of St. Maries at the two most usuall feasts in the Year Viz. the feast of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary & St. Michael the Archangel by Even and Equall portions the Rent of One Shilling Sterl. in Silver or Gold and for a fine upon Every Alienation of the Said Land or any part or parcell thereof One Whole Years Rent in Silver or Gold or the full Value thereof in Such Commodities as we and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers as shall be appointed by us and our Heirs from time to time to Collect and Receive the Same shall Accept in Discharge thereof at the Choice of us and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers afores. Provided that if the S. Sum for a fine for Alienation shall not be paid unto us and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers afores. before Such Alienation And the Said Alienation Ent. upon Record either in the Prob. Court or County Court Where the Same parcell of Land Lyeth w. in one Month next after Such Alienation then the said Alienation shall be void and of no Effect Given under our Great Seal of our Said Province of Maryland this fifteenth Day of October Seventeen hundred and Thirty One Witness our Dear Brother President Geo. East Eighty fathoms then North fifty Deg. East two Hundred and Twenty fathoms then South thirty Deg.
