


Alterations Made by our Instructions bearing Date at London the Twelfth Day  
of September Seventeen hundred and Twelve and Registered in our Secretary's  
Office of our Said Province We do therefore hereby Grant unto him the  
Said Abraham Ingram all that the aforesaid Tract or parcel of Land  
Called Sheep Pen Mill Situate lying and Being in Sommersett Cott on  
the Seaboard Side on the head of the Indian at Baltimore River bound  
as followeth Beginning at a Marke White Oak standing on the East  
Side of a Branch of Said River called Shiloh Branch abt. thirty Yards to the  
South East of the Main Road over Said Branch and near the Wading place  
over Said Branch and from thence w<sup>t</sup> a Line drawn North Thirty Deg<sup>r</sup> West  
Fifteen poles thence West Eighty pole thence South One hundred and  
Fifteen poles thence East fifty four poles and from thence with a right Line drawn  
to the first Bounder containing and now Laid out for fifty Acres of Land more  
or Less According to the Certificate of Survey therof taken and Returned into  
our Land Office bearing Date the Twentieth Day of Septe Seventeen hundred  
and Twenty Nine and there Remaining together with all Rights profits  
and Privileges therunto belonging (Royall Mines Excepted) To  
Have and to Hold the same unto him the Said Abraham Ingram his  
Heirs and Assigns for Ever to be holder of us and our Heirs as of our Manors  
Sommersett in free and Common Socage by Fealty only for all Manner of  
Services Yielding and Paying therefore yearly unto us and our Heirs at our Re-  
ceipt at the City of St. Maries at the two most usuall feasts in the Year Viz.  
the feast of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary & St. Michael then  
Archangel by Even and Equall portions the Rent of One Shilling Sterl. in  
Silver or Gold and for a fine upon Every Alienation of the Said Land or any  
part or parcel thereof One Whole Years Rent in Silver or Gold or the full  
Value thereof in such Commodities as we and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers  
as shall be appointed by us and our Heirs from time to time to Collect and Receive  
the same shall Accept in Discharge thereof at the Choice of us and our Heirs  
or such Officer or Officers aforesd Provided that if the sum for a fine  
for Alienation Shall not be paid unto us and our Heirs or such Officer  
or Officers aforesd before such Alienation And the Said Alienation Ent<sup>d</sup> upon  
Record either in the Provl<sup>l</sup> Court or County Court Where the same parcel of  
Land lyeth w<sup>t</sup>in one Month next after such Alienation then the said  
Alienation shall be void and of no Effect Given under our Great Seal of  
our Said Province of Maryland this Fifteenth Day of October Seventeen  
hundred and Thirty One Witness our Dear Brother Benedict Lord Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup>  
Governour and Commander in Chief in and over our said Province of Maryland  
Chanc<sup>r</sup> and Keeper of the Great Seal therof

Hundred and Eighty four and Remaining upon Record in our Said Province of Maryland with such Alterations as in them are made by our further Instructions bearing Date the Fourth Day of December Sixteen hundred and Ninety Six together also with the Alterations made by our Instructions bearing Date at London the Twelfth Day of September Seventeen Hundred and Twelve and Registered in our Secretary's Office of our Said Province WE DO therefore hereby Grant unto him the Said Stephen Union all that Tract or parcell of Land Called Creek Hill Lying in Baltimore County about three Miles West from Susquehannah River and about a Mile from the South Side of a Creek Called Broad Creek BEGINNING at Michael Frenches Spring which Run into a Small branch Called Greencoat Cabin Branch and is about Eighty fches to the Eastward of the said Branch and Running thence South Sixty Degrees West Eighty fches up North Thirty Degrees West Eighty fches then North Sixty Deg. East Eighty fches then North fifty Deg. East two Hundred and Twenty fches then South Thirty Deg. East Eighty fches then by a Direct Line to the first Beginning Cont'd. and now Laid out for One hundred and fifty Acres of Land more or Less according to the Certificate of Survey thereof taken and returned into our Land Office bearing Date the Tenth Day of November Seventeen hundred and thirty and there Remaining together w<sup>t</sup> all Rights profits Benefits and Priviledges thereunto belonging (Royall Mines Excepted) TO HAVE and to HOLD the same unto him the Said Stephen Union his Heirs and Assigns for Ever to be helden of us and our Heirs as of our Manor of Baltimore County in free and Common Socage by fealty only for all manner of Services Yielding and Paying therefore Yearly unto us and our Heirs at our Receipt at the City of St. Maries at the two most usuall feasts in the Year vizt the Feast of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary & St. Michael the Archangel by Even and Equall portions the Rent of Six Shillings Sterl. in Silver or Gold And for a fine upon Every alienation of the Said Land or any part or parcell thereof a Whole Years Rent in Silver or Gold or the full Value thereof in such Commodities as we and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers as shall be appointed by us or our Heirs from time to time to collect and receive the same shall accept in Discharge thereof at the Choice of us and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers afores<sup>d</sup> PROVIDED that if the sum for a fine for alienation shall not be paid unto us and our Heirs or such Officer or Officers afores<sup>d</sup> before such alienation and the same alienation Ent<sup>d</sup> upon Record either in the Proo<sup>r</sup> Court or County Court where the same parcell of Land lyeth w<sup>t</sup>in one Month next after such alienation then the sum for alienation shall be bid and of no Effect by W<sup>e</sup> under our Great Seal of our Said Province of Maryland this Twentieth Day of September Seventeen hundred and thirty One Witness our Dear Brother Benedict Leonard Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Gouvernour and Commander in Chief in and over our Said Province of Maryland Chanc<sup>r</sup> and Keeper of the Great Seal thereof do the great Seal of Maryland *Calvert Chan.*
