THIS DEED made this 3rd day of September, in the year 1929, by A. Pierson Pyle and Alma E. Pyle, his wife, of Harford County, in the State of Maryland.

WITNESSETH that for and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) cash in hand paid and other good and valuable considerations, (a part whereof is the assumption by the grantees hereinafter named of a Mortgage of Seventeen Hundred Dollars (\$1700.00) held by Roxie K. Tennant, dated February 23, 1917, and recorded among the Land Records of Harford County, aforesaid, in Liber J.A.R. No. 154, folio 384), the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the said A. PIERSON PYLE and ALMA E. PYLE, his wife, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto CHARLES A. GLACKIN and MAHALA GLACKIN, his wife, as tenants by entireties, their heirs and assigns, in fee simple, all that certain farm, tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the FIFTH ELECTION DISTRICT of Harford County, aforesaid, on the South side of the Public Road leading from Tabernacle Church to the Dublin and Whiteford State Road, containing eighty-six (86) acres of land, more or less, and being the same and all the land described in and conveyed by a deed from William S. Pyle and wife, to the said A. Pierson Pyle and Alma E. Pyle, his wife, dated the 23rd day of February, in the year 1917, and recorded among the aforesaid Land Records in Liber J.A.R. No. 155, folio ⁷⁶~~176~~.

TOGETHER WITH the buildings and improvements thereon and all the rights, roads, ways, waters, privileges, advantages and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said CHARLES A. GLACKIN and MAHALA GLACKIN, his wife, as tenants by entireties, their assigns or the heirs or assigns of the survivor, forever, in fee simple. AND THE SAID A. Pierson Pyle and Alma E. Pyle, his wife, covenant to warrant specially the lands and premises above described and mentioned and hereby intended to be conveyed, except as to the aforesaid Mortgage, and agree to execute such other and further assurances as may at any time become necessary or requisite.
