redemption of the sum of one hundred and fifty four Dollars and forty cents
good and lawful money of Maryland to me in hand paid by the said
George McCasland and the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and
therefrom fully acquit - release and discharge the said George McCasland
his heirs Executors and administrators to the said Robert Barclay to the
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell
transfer and finally make over unto the said George McCasland all his right
title claim interest and demand in and to the ^{part of} undivided right and share
of the following tract of Land lying and being in Harford County aforesaid
viz The undivided one sixth part of a tract of Land called the green on
Cassell containing three hundred and ninety two acres more or less the
undivided one sixth part of a tract called Prospect same part of said
tract containing thirty three acres more or less which was purchased from
Joseph Mullen by J. H. Barclay and do appear as will appear on the
records of the said County and the undivided one sixth part of a smaller tract
called Barclay's Hope or the Hope as will more fully appear on the
records of the said office at Annapolis and also have my undivided right
and share in said Land and Equity of all the Land and their appurtenances
