teen hundred and ninety seven Between Rachel Husband, Mary Husband and
Susannah Bagley wife of William Bagley of Harford County State of Maryland
of the one part and Elizabeth Quarles wife of John Quarles of the other
part Witnesseth that whereas William Husband late of Harford deceased do by
his last will and Testament bequeath all his Real Estate to his four daughters to
wit Rachel, Mary, Susanna, and Elizabeth Husband to be equally divided between
them according to Quantity and Quality and whereas the said Susanna Husband has
Intermarried with William Bagley and Elizabeth Husband has Intermarried with
John Quarles and whereas the said four Sisters Daughters of the said William Husband
deceased did petition the worshipful Judges of the Orphans Court for the County aforesaid
to obtain a legal partition of the said Real Estate the Judges of the Orphans Court aforesaid
did appoint Capt. Samuel Gilpin of Cecil County with the Consent and approbation
of the Chiefes and legal Representatives of the said William Husband to divide the
Real Estate aforesaid agreeably to the last will of the said William Husband which the
said Capt. Samuel Gilpin has done and fully to the satisfaction of all and every the
aforesaid Daughters the sole Heires of the said William Husband &c
This Indenture further Witnesseth that the said Rachel Husband,
Mary Husband and Susanna Bagley wife of William Bagley for and in Consider-
ation of one Dollar lawful Money of the United States of America to them in hand
paid by the said Elizabeth Quarles wife of John Quarles the Receipt whereof they
do hereby acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied and thereof do acquit and

Discharged the said Elizabeth Quarles wife of John Quarles Have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell all that Tract or parcel of Land
 lying and being in the said County of Hartford on Broad Creek and which was purchased
 of Luchens Union by the said William Husband Deceased and Conveyed by the Executors of
 the said Luchens Union to Rachel Mary Swanna and Elizabeth Husbans Coheives
 of William Husband Deceased known by the name of Clechill Enlarged on the North
 side of Deer Creek and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at Michael Finches
 Spring which runs into a small Branch called Green Coat Cabin Branch and is
 about eighty perches to the Eastward of said Branch and running thence South fourteen
 Degrees West Twenty perches South forty three Degrees West Twenty perches
 South three Degrees East five perches South fifty two Degrees East Twenty eight
 perches South seventy two Degrees East forty perches South five Degrees East

 assigns forever the said Rachel Husband, Mary Hubbard and Susanna Bageley

 Conveyances that may be reasonably devised or required by the said Elizabeth Quarles
 wife of John Quarles her Heirs or assigns or her or their Council Learned in
 the Law and at the proper Cost and Charge of the said Elizabeth Quarles wife of
 John Quarles provided no other Warrantee is required there is herein specified

William Bagley the partition line to begin at a bounder Mulberry sapling and stone
