hundred and ninety seven Between Rachel Husband, Mary Husband and
Susanna Bageley wife of William Bageley of Harford County State of Maryland
of the one part and Elizabeth Quarles wife of John Quarles of the other
part Witnesseth that whereas William Husband late of Harford deceased died by
his last will and Testament bequeath all his Real Estate to his four daughters to
wit Rachel, Mary Susanna, and Elizabeth Husband to be equally divided between
them according to Quantity and Duality and whereas the said Susanna Husband has
Intermarried with William Bageley and Elizabeth Husband has Intermarried with
John Quarles and whereas the said four Sisters daughters of the said William Husband
deceased did petition the worshipful Judges of the Orphans Court for the County aforesaid
to obtain a legal partition of the said Real Estate the Judges of the Orphans Court aforesaid
did appoint Capt. Samuel Gilpin of Cecil County with the Consent and approbation
of the Chieffers and legal Representatives of the said William Husband to divide the
Real Estate aforesaid agreeably to the last will of the said William Husband which the
said Capt. Samuel Gilpin has done and fully to the satisfaction of all and every the
aforesaid Daughters the sole Heiresses of the said William Husband Now
this Indenture further Witnesseth that the said Rachel Husband,
Mary Husband and Susanna Bageley wife of William Bageley for and in considera-
tion of one Dollar lawful Money of the United States of America to them in hand
paid by the said Elizabeth Quarles wife of John Quarles the Recettor whereof they
do hereby acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied and thereof to acquit and

and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell all that Tract or parcel of Land -
lying and being in the said County of Harford on Broad Creek and which was purchased
of Loucheus Onion by the said William Husband deceased and Conveyed by the Executors of
the said Loucheus Onion to Rachel Mary Susanna and Elizabeth Husband Coheirress
of William Husband deceased known by the name of Cleekhill Enlarged on the North
side of Deer Creek and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at Michael Pinches
Spring which runs into a small Branch Called Green Coat Callin Branch and is
about eighty perches to the Eastward of said Branch and running thence South fourteen

of one part and Rachel Husband of the County and State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that whereas William Husband late of Harford County deceased did
by his last will and Testament bequeath all his Real Estate to his four daughters to wit
Rachel, Mary, Susanna and Elizabeth Husband to be Equally divided between them
according to Quantity and Quality and whereas the said Susanna Husband Hath
since Intermarried with William Bagley and the said Elizabeth Husband Hath also
Intermarried with John Darles and whereas the four Sisters Daughters of the said
William Husband did petition the Worshipful Judges of the Orphans Court for the
County aforesaid to obtain a legal partition of the Real Estate of William Husband deceased

William Bagley the partition line to begin at a bounder Mulberry sapling and stone
Marked thus and running thence the following Courses and distances toward South one
Degree East Twenty two perches and a half perch to a stone or Mulberry post thence
