






Deed Dated 15<sup>th</sup> 1814 Delv'd Asael Hitchcock  
This Indenture made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between  
Henry Myers and his wife Sarah of Richland Township Berango County and State of Pennsylvania but formerly  
of Harford County and State of Maryland of the one part and Charles Baker Hitchcock of Harford County and  
State of Maryland of the other part; whereas the Intendant of the aforesaid was by law vested with full power  
and lawful authority and was directed to sell and dispose of all lands and tenements in the State of Maryland in pursu-  
ance whereof the said Intendant exposed the same to sale and a certain Aquila Brings became the  
purchaser of part of the said lands in Harford County, and whereas the said Aquila Brings took  
the benefit of the insolvent act, and William Jones of Jarmy, was appointed his trustee with John Surveyor  
for him March the twenty fifth day A.D. 1790 a tract of land it being a part of the said aforesaid purchase  
by the aforesaid Aquila Brings before recited containing two hundred and twenty three acres and three  
quarters of an acre and lying at the Verdant Paling, which tract of land the said William Jones sold  
transferred and made over unto the aforesaid Henry Myers, and his heirs and assigns as appears by the  
affidavit endorsed on the certificate of said Surveyor filed in the Land office on the western Shore  
bearing date the twenty fifth day of January A.D. 1794 and afterwards on the seventeenth day of March  
following patent was granted to the said Henry Myers. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
