 Wilmerspoth whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Harford County sitting as a Court of Equity passed on the 15th day
 of June 1886 in the case of Henry W. Archer and Henry
 W. Samandis Trustees vs. John C. Mc Casland and others
 the said Henry W. Archer Jr. Trustee was appointed Trustee
 to sell the land decreed to be sold and has sold the same
 to William Young Trustee of Mary E. Young wife of said
 William Young who has fully paid the purchase money
 therefor Now therefore in consideration of the premises
 and the sum of One dollar the said Henry W. Archer Jr.
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said William Young
 Trustee as aforesaid all the right title and interest of all the
 parties to the aforesaid cause in and to all that tract or parcel
 of land situated in Harford County and State of Maryland
 known as the Reese Farm or George. W. Caslands Upper Farm
 containing 207 acres of Land more or less which was conveyed
 by John P. Board and J. W. Casland Trustee to John
 W. Casland by deed dated on or about the 11th day of Novem-
 ber 1856 and recorded in Liber A. L. J. No. 8 folio 168 one
 of the land Records of the Circuit Court for Harford County with
 the improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining Free Clear and discharged from all claim of the
 parties to said cause.
