

AFFAIRS IN CAROLINE COUNTY.—We copy the following from the Denton Journal:

Court.—The October term of the Circuit Court for this county commenced its session on Monday last, his Honor Judge Hopper on the bench. Nearly the entire session on Thursday was occupied in the trial of the negro girl Josephine Webb, for poisoning her mistress, Miss Mary E. A. Reed.—The jury returned a verdict of "guilty of murder in the second degree." She has been sentenced to 15 years' imprisonment in the penitentiary.
