 Richard Harwood by and under the twenty third day  
 of July in the year one thousand seven hundred  
 and ninety six, and that his freedom commenced on  
 the twelfth day of September one thousand eight  
 hundred and thirteen; and that the said negro man  
 named Charles was raised in the County aforesaid
