

ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS REWARD.—**K**en away from the subscribers, near Clarksburg, Montgomery county, Md. six negro men, as follows: **WILLIAM BOWIE**, **JOHN BOWIE**, and **DANIEL BOWIE**, belonging to Nathaniel M. Waters; **GEORGE CONRAD**, belonging to Edwin Waters; and **LAUNCELOT JOHNSON** and **LONDON JOHNSON**, belonging to Jane Magruder. **WILLIAM** is a light mulatto, about 5 feet 10 inches high, 33 years old, very bow-legged, bald on the top of the head, a blacksmith by trade, and a tolerable shoemaker; has been subject to the quinsy, and has, it is probable, scars on his throat from blisters. **JOHN** is a likely dark mulatto, about 28 years old, 5 feet 10 inches high, has very bushy hair, a scar on his right leg, and had recently cut his little toe, which can scarcely be well yet, is pleasant when spoken to, has a sprightly eye, rather fine voice, and is a rough carpenter. **DANIEL** is a lad, 18 or 19 years old, also a dark mulatto, 5 feet 8 inches high, face full of spots, some places darker than others. **GEORGE CONRAD** is 30 years old, about 5 feet high, very black, is slender made, has scars on his breast from cupping, and a sore or scar on his leg. **LAUNCELOT** is 30 years old, about 5 feet 7 inches high, rather light made, is bow-legged, and shows largely the whites of his eyes. **LONDON** is about 28 years old, supposed 5 feet 10 inches high, grim countenance, large flat nose, and is a stout able bodied man, also shows prominently the whites of his eyes; both the last mentioned are black.

These negroes all started in company, (and will probably keep together,) and made directly for Pennsylvania; at Harrisburg in which State the gang were arrested on the 6th of June, and by an abolition magistrate set at liberty, (though acknowledging themselves slaves,) then carried off by a negro preacher in his carriage, direction not known, since which they have not been heard of. We will give One Thousand Dollars for the arrest and safe return to us of the above six negroes, either at our residences or in any safe jail in Maryland; or if taken and returned as above, separately, for William, John, Launcelot, and London, each two hundred dollars; and for George and Daniel, each one hundred dollars.
