 said Lilly Webb, Mary Ann Hughs and Sophia Webb, being by us examined out of the presence
 and hearing of her said husband whether they do execute and acknowledge the same freely
 and voluntarily, and without being induced to do so by fear or threats, or ill usage by their husbands

 same deed and endow ment were enrolled as follows to wit: This Indenture, made this twentieth day
 of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty six, between Perry G. Stevens
 and Elizabeth Stevens his wife of Caroline County in the State of Maryland of the one part and
 Charles Connolly of Dorchester and James Campen of Caroline County and State aforesaid of the other
 part; Witnesseth that the said Perry G. Stevens and Elizabeth Stevens his wife for and in
 consideration of the sum of fifteen Hundred Dollars  law current money of Maryland to them in
 hand paid by the said Charles Connolly and James Campen before the execution of this Indenture
 the receipt whereof they the said Perry G. Stevens and Elizabeth Stevens his wife do hereby acknowl-
 edge and from the same and every part and parcel thereof do hereby forever Exonerate acquit and discharge
 the said Charles Connolly and James Campen their heirs executors administrators and assigns Have given
 granted bargained sold Aliened released Enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed unto the said Charles
 Connolly and James Campen their heirs and assigns forever all those tracts or parts of Tracts or parcels of
 Land Lying and being in Caroline County in the State of Maryland on the east side of the Choptank
 River called Binton woods Next part of Mischanes Bettlers Landing Siverton Alocks chance and
 Glys Kindness and containing four hundred and thirty eight acus of Land be the same more
 or less, It being the Land which was in the occupaney and possession of the late William P
 Kelly at the time of his death and which was conveyed by James L Bartol Trustee to the said
 Perry G. Stevens by Deed bearing date the fourteenth day of April eighteen hundred and forty six (referred
