

Schoolhouse Burned.

ROCKVILLE, Md., Feb. 18.—The Colored Public Schoolhouse at Quince Orchard, Montgomery county, was recently destroyed by fire, entailing a loss of several hundred dollars. The fire is believed to have been the work of the party or parties who have recently made several attempts at incendiarism in the Quince Orchard neighborhood. The County School Commissioners have decided to offer a reward of \$50 for the apprehension of the guilty persons and the company in which the building was insured has offered a similar reward. It is stated that the County Commissioners will also offer a reward.
