Caroline County to w^{it}; Be it remembered that on the twenty fourth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, came Henry M. Godwin of Caroline County and brought a Deed of Trust with one endorsement thereon and prayed to have the same enrolled among the records of Caroline County and on the same day and year aforesaid the same Deed and endorsement were enrolled as follows to w^{it} -

This Indenture made this twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Step Harper (free negro) of Caroline County Maryland of the one part, and Henry M. Godwin of the same place of the other part, whereas on application of the said Step Harper (free negro) to the Honorable Richard Chambers one of the Judges of the orphans Court of Caroline County for the benefit of the several acts of assembly for the relief of insolvent debtors the said Judge did on the 23^d day of April Eighteen hundred and twenty nine appoint the above named Henry M. Godwin as Trustee on behalf of the creditors of the said Step Harper and did direct that the said Step Harper should execute a Deed to the said Trustee for all his estate, real personal, and mixed, (excepting the necessary wearing apparel and bedding of himself and family) in trust for the said creditors of the said Step Harper; Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Step Harper in pursuance of the order of the said Richard Chambers one of the Judges of the orphans Court as aforesaid, and to obtain the benefit of the said acts of assembly, and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar current money to him in hand paid by the said Henry M. Godwin hath granted bargained and sold assigned transferred and set over and by these presents doth fully grant bargain sell, transfer assign and set over unto the said Henry M. Godwin and his assigns all and every the household goods and furniture effects and Chattels debts and sums of money, belonging to and due and owing to the said Step Harper as are in the schedule of the said Step Harper annexed to his Petition particularly mentioned and also all other property real personal and mixed, of what kind quality or nature soever (excepting the necessary apparel and bedding of himself and family) that the said Step Harper has or claims any title to or interest in and all debts rights and claims which he has or that he is in any respect entitled to in possession remainder or reversion to have and to hold the same, and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Henry M. Godwin and his assigns in trust to and for the creditors of the said Step Harper and for their benefit agreeable to the acts of assembly in such case made and provided; In witness whereof the said Step Harper hath hereunto set his name and affixed his seal the day and year first herein before written. - ^{by} Step Harper ^{reads} Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of - ^{make} Thomas Jones - R^d Chambers - Maryland Caroline County to w^{it}; Be it remembered that on this 23^d day of April anno Domini Eighteen hundred and twenty nine personally appears Step Harper the party grantor with us named before us the subscribers two of the Justices of the Peace of the state of Maryland in and for Caroline County and acknowledges the aforesaid to be the true intent and meaning of the same and the acts of assembly in such case made and provided - Taken and certified the day and year above written before - Thomas Jones R^d Chambers

Caroline County to w^{it}; Be it remembered that on the twenty eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, came Edward Clark of Caroline County and brought a Deed of Trust with one endorsement thereon and prayed to have the same enrolled among the records of Caroline County, and on the same day and year aforesaid the same Deed and endorsement were enrolled as follows to w^{it} -

This Indenture made this 15th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty nine, between Daniel Rich of Caroline County of the one part, and Edward Clark of Caroline County of the other part; whereas on application of the said Daniel Rich to the Honorable Richard Chambers, one of the Justices of the orphans Court for Caroline County for the benefit of the act of assembly for the relief of every insolvent debtor passed at November session Eighteen hundred and five and the supplements thereto the said Richard Chambers did on the 15th day of April Eighteen hundred and twenty nine appoint the above named Edward Clark Trustee on behalf of the creditors of the said Daniel Rich and did direct that the said Daniel Rich should execute a Deed to the said Trustee for all his property, debts rights and claims (excepting the necessary wearing apparel of himself and family) in trust for the said creditors of the said Daniel Rich. - Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Daniel Rich in pursuance of the order of the said Richard Chambers and to obtain the benefit of the said act of assembly and supplements and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar
