Had on when he went away, a short blue coat, white cotton ribb'd breeches, a white shirt ruffled at the bosom, a large bound black hat, white stockings, and strong coarse shoes with large pinchbeck buckles.

Whoever apprehends said SLAVE, and delivers him to his Master, or secures him in any goal in this State, and gives due notice thereof, shall receive the above Reward, with the payment of reasonable charges.
