

*Aquasco, Prince George's County, Sept. 6, 1783.*

Left the subscriber on the 20th day of May last, at Little-Annamelick, Somerset County, a Negro Fellow named ANTHONY, though during his stay there (which was for nearly 11 months) called himself JACOB; he is about 25 years old, 5 feet 3 or 4 inches high, lingo in his talk, and limps in his walk; the latter owing to a hurt which he received some years ago from a fall out of a cart. He frequently talks of his relations at Mr. Fielder Bowie's, of whom I purchased him. Whoever takes up said Negro, and secures him so that the subscriber may get him, shall receive *Five Pounds Reward, or Twenty Dollars*, if brought to me on Patuxent River, a few miles above Benedict, and reasonable charges paid by
