

Sixty Dollars Reward.

RAN AWAY, from Northampton County, on the Eastern-Shore of Virginia, **THREE NEGROES**, viz.—**SAM**, a thick short black fellow, about 27 years of age, much marked with the small-pox; **NED**, pretty much of the same age and make, but rather taller and of a brighter colour than **SAM**;—and **EDMUND**, a tall slender yellow lad, about 17 years of age, with large full eyes. These Negroes were raised near Petersburg, in Virginia, and were seen on the 8th Inst. after crossing Pocomoke-River, at Shell-Town Ferry, on the main Somerset road, six miles above the Ferry. Each of them carried with him a small bundle of clothes and a pair of boots. It is probable they will endeavour to get across the Bay, pretty high up, and travel by land into the neighbourhood they were raised in. Any person who will take up and deliver said **NEGROES** to **GILBERT ROBERTSON**, Esq; at *Norfolk*; to **Mr. SIMON FRASER**, at *Petersburg*; or to the Gaolers in *Northampton* or *Accomack* Counties, on the *Eastern-Shore*, shall receive the above Reward.
