

A Runaway Negro

Was committed to the gaol of Washington county, in the state of Maryland, on the 12th inst. (June) as a runaway, a Negro man named JAMES BROWN, about 23 or 24 years of age, 5 feet 6 or 7 inches high; had on when committed a lead coloured cloth roundabout, drab cloth pantaloons and tow shirt—He says he had on when he ran away, a blue nankeen roundabout and pantaloons—that he belongs to a Mr. Biggs, who was taking him to Carolina, and that he was formerly the property of John Sutton on the Eastern shore, Maryland. His owner is desired to take him away, or he will be sold for his gaol fees, &c. according to law.
