RUNAWAYS.

WERE committed to the Jail of Washington County, District of Columbia, the fol-

lowing persons as runaway negroes :

William Daniels, on the 17th of June last; he is 5 feet 7½ inches high; says he is 28 years old, and that he was set free by Warner Mifflin, near Dover, state of Delsware—had on when committed, fur hat, blue cloath coat, linen shirt, and blue cloath trowsers.

On the 23d, Sam Taylor, a bright mulatto, he is 5 feet 6½ inches high, says he is 18 years old, and that he was born free and has a father living in Petersburg, Virginia, by the name of Thomas Taylor; had on when committed, wool hat, red flannel shirt and striped cotton

trowsers.

On the 26th of June, negro Levin Jones, he is 5 feet 6 inches high, says he is 21 years old, and that he served his time with Peter Herrington Scanor, of Dorchester County, Maryland; his cloathing hard to describe as they are much worn.

The owners of the above negroes, if any, are requested to come and prove them and take them away, or they will be sold for their jail fees and other expences as the law directs.
