He had on when he went away a knapt great coat of a lead color, with a large cape; his other clothing not known, as he had many. One of his hands was nearly cut off when a small boy; it is now quite well, and does not prevent him from labor. The scar is very plain, and it is supposed to be on the left hand.

On Monday, the 22d inst. NANCY, the wife of William, went off. She is 30 years of age, very good looking woman, 5 feet 6 or 7 inches high; she wears earrings; her clothing is not known, as she had many. Those negroes were purchased last November of Mrs. Ann Berry, in this neighborhood. The woman was purchased when a small girl from the estate of the late Notley Young, Esq. She has some connexions at Mr. Nicholas Young's, Nonsuch, where it is probable she may be. She is very handy, and a good sempstress. Whoever will take up and secure the said negroes in any jail, so that I get them again, within the State, or District of Columbia, shall receive 70 dollars. If out of the State, or District of Columbia, the above reward, and all reasonable expenses paid.
