

WAS committed on the 18th day of May, 1825, to the jail of Baltimore county, by Henry W. Gray, Esq. a Justice of the Peace for the city of Baltimore, as a runaway slave, a negro man who calls himself JOSEPH COOPER, and says he belongs to Kendle Lewis, Sussex County, state of Delaware. He is about 26 years of age, 5 feet 4 inches high; had on when committed a drab cloth over jacket, no vest, light colored cloth pantaloons, coarse linen shirt, and no stockings and shoes, and covered seaman's hat. The owner of the above described negro is desired to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
