

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore County on the first day of October, 1823, by Thomas Sheppard, esq. a Justice of the Peace for Baltimore City, as a runaway, a negro Girl who calls herself **HARRIET** and says she belongs to Mrs. Deborah V right, of Easton Talbot county, E. S. Maryland, but that she recently lived with Mr. Neibling on the Market street road; said negro is 5 feet 1 inch high and about 21 years of age, had on when committed a blue linsey frock with white and red stripes, fine shoes and stockings.—The owner of the above described negro woman is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take her away, otherwise she will be discharged according to law.
