

**W**AS committed to the Gaol of Baltimore county, on the 24th day of November, 1829, by Richard Middleton, Esq. a Justice of the Peace in and for the city of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro man, who calls himself ISAAC TRAVERSE, and says he belong to John Creighton, of Dorset county, E. S. of Maryland. Said negro is five feet six inches high, and about thirty five years of age. Had on when committed a drab monkey jacket, red flannel shirt, blue cloth pantaloons, and tarpaulin hat and fine shoes and stockings.

The owner of the above described negro man is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
