

**W**AS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore County on the 22d day of May, 1830, by Henry W. Gray, Esq. a Justice of the Peace for the City of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro man who calls himself PETER CORNISH; says he belongs to Wm. Allen of Cambridge, Eastern Shore, Maryland. Said negro is five feet nine and a half inches high; about twenty-five years of age. Had on when committed, a brown striped vest, lindsey cotton shirt, striped lindsey pantaloons, an old fur hat, coarse shoes and stockings, a small bundle containing one pair of pantaloons, an old blue cloth roundabout. The owner of the above described negro man is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away; otherwise, he will be discharged according to law.
