Said negro man is about thirty four years old, five feet nine and a half inches high; his left arm appears to have been broken, and the top of his left ear bit off. Had on when committed, a striped do:nestic roundabout, swansdown vest, coarse linen pantaloons, cotton shirt, tarpaulan hat, cotton stockings and coarse shoes—had with him a bundle of clothes.
