

**W**AS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore County on the 1st day of September, 1830, by Chas. Kernan, Esq. a Justice of the Peace in and for the City of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro man who calls himself JAMES RITTER—says he is free, and did belong to Wm. Tall, of Dorchester County, Eastern Shore of Maryland. Said negro man is about thirty-four years old, five feet nine and a half inches high; his left arm appears to have been broken, and the top of his left ear bit off. Had on when committed, a striped domestic roundabout, swansdown vest, coarse linen pantaloons, cotton shirt, tarpaulan hat, cotton stockings and coarse shoes—had with him a bundle of clothes.

The owner of the above described negro man is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away: otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
