

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore city and county, on the 11th day of December, 1833, by Ephraim Smith, Esq., a Justice of the Peace in and for the City of Baltimore, as a runaway, a colored lad, who calls himself **ROBERT HARRIS**; says he belongs to Mrs. Elizabeth Thompson, living near Cambridge, E. Shore, Md., but was committed as belonging to Jesso Bulling, near Cambridge. Said colored lad is about 16 years of age, 5 feet 2 1-2 inches high, very much scarred on his back from a cow-hide, large scar on his right leg, large scar on his left leg, with several scars on both hands. Had on, when committed, a pair of old light blue cassimere pantaloons, cotton shirt, white summer round-about, straw hat and a pair of coarse lace boots.

The owner (if any) of the above-described colored lad is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
