

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Talbot County, on the 4th day of June inst. by William H. Hayward, Esq. a Justice of the Peace for Talbot County, a negro man named Abel West, alias Able Bayly, who says he came out of the estate of Molly Bayly, and belongs to Jonathan West near Drummond town, Accomack County, Eastern Shore of Virginia. He is about 23 years of age, 5 feet 9 inches high, and of dark complexion, he has a large scar on his left leg caused by a burn, his clothing consists of a brown cassinet roundabout and pantaloons, striped worsted waistcoat, cotton shirt, white cotton stockings, fine leather shoes and old fur hat.

The owner, if any, of the above described negro is requested to come forward, prove property pay charges and take him away otherwise he will be discharged as required by the act of Assembly.
