

400 DOLLARS REWARD.—Runaway from the subscribers living on Taylor's Island, Dorchester County, Maryland, on Saturday October 1st, a negro man named BOB, aged about 22 years, of a dark chestnut color, and 5 feet 6 or 7 inches high. He had on when he went away a pair of blue pantaloons and cloth coat, his other clothing not recollected, he took with him a large Batteau named "Fox of Parson's Creek" belonging to Mr. J. M. Pattison—which Batteau has been found at the Spring Gardens near this city. Also a Negro Man named JAKE, about the same height as Bob, is very black, clothing &c. not recollected.
